The newly remodeled Sybil Wood McRay Genealogy & Local History Collection will be open to the public from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., so you can arrive early and stay until midnight. At 4:00 p.m. the library doors will close. If you plan to arrive after 4:00 p.m., please contact staff for details on getting in, as the building will be locked. The second floor will remain open until midnight for genealogists.

**This event is not for beginners or the faint of heart! The cost is \$13.00 per person.**

The Sybil Wood McRay Genealogy & Local History Collection offers full online access to the Ancestry Library Edition Database which includes the Federal Census for the United States; Heritage Quest Online, and the ever-expanding Georgia's Historic Newspapers Collection available through the Digital Library of Georgia.

Our newest database addition is MyHeritage Library Edition which features more than 9 billion historical records from the United States, Europe, Latin America, and other regions, Census of England and Wales (1841-1901) with images, and more than 816 million US public records. Staff will be available to assist you during the event on August 13<sup>th</sup>.

The Hall County Library System is a FamilySearch affiliate library. A major benefit of being an affiliate library is access to additional digital records not available outside a family history center or an affiliate library. These digital records include image and name indexes. Currently, there are more than 400 million original records available in a digital format that affiliate libraries can access. We also have microfilm of local Hall County newspapers starting in the late 1800s through the present and cemetery records.
